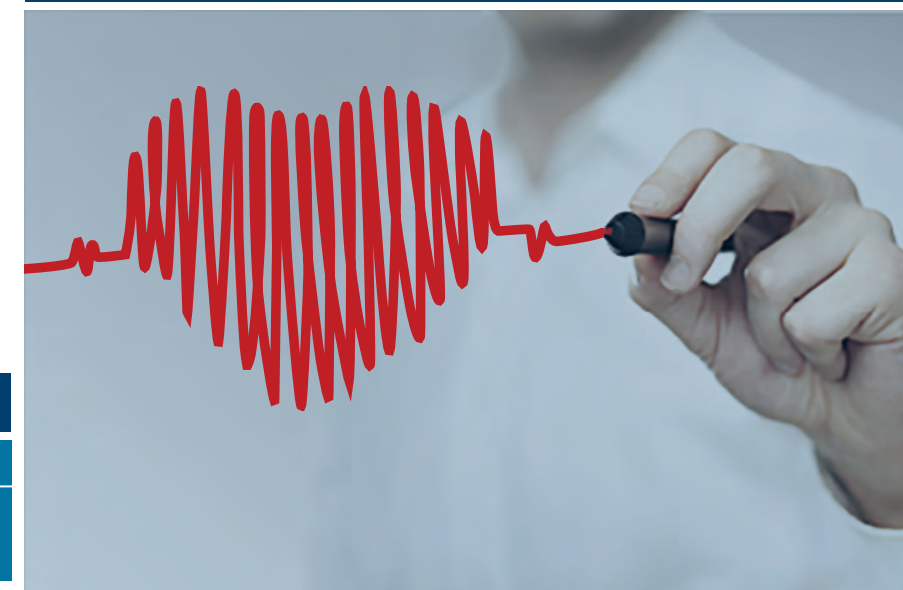

Nanette Wenger, MD, MACC, MACP, FAHA is Professor of Medicine, Division of Cardiology at the Emory University School of Medicine and a consultant to the Emory Heart and Vascular Center. Coronary heart disease in women is one of Dr. Wenger's major clinical and research interests. Dr. Wenger has expertise in cardiac rehabilitation.

In 2013, she received the Inaugural Distinguished Mentor Award of the American College of Cardiology. Dr. Wenger has participated as an author of several American College of Cardiology/American Heart Association Clinical Practice Guidelines. Dr. Wenger serves on the editorial boards of numerous professional journals and is a sought after lecturer for issues related to heart disease in women, heart disease in the elderly, cardiac rehabilitation, coronary prevention, and contemporary cardiac care. Dr. Wenger has authored or coauthored over 1500 scientific and review articles and book chapters.
